Where to Count:

North Palm Beach County Circle-Center at Donald Ross Road & The Turnpike

Central Palm Beach County Circle-Center at Forest Hill & The Turnpike

South Palm Beach County Circle-Center at Linton Blvd. & Carter Road

When to Count: You *must* count on **June 25th** if your home is 7.5 miles from the center of the Central circle. You *must* count on **June 26th** if your home is 7.5 miles from the center of the North circle. You *must* count on **July 2nd** if your home is 7.5 miles from the center of the South circle. For more info call at 561/706-6732.

How to Count: Garden watchers will report the highest number of individuals of any species seen at one time in the garden. Do not add the total observations for the entire day. For example, a garden watcher may walk through his/her garden 3x in an hour. On the first pass s/he saw 3 monarchs and 5 zebras. On the second pass, 2 monarchs and 8 zebras. On the third pass, 4 monarchs and 6 zebras. S/he will report on this form that s/he saw 4 monarchs and 8 zebras. **Please be specific: Vague data will not be included! (ie – “too many to count”, “larvae on passionvine” without species, etc.)**
