You *must* count on **June 15<sup>th</sup>** if your home is 7.5 miles from the center of the **South circle**.

You *must* count on **June 22<sup>nd</sup>** if your home is 7.5 miles from the center of the **Central circle**.

You *must* count on **June 23<sup>rd</sup>** if your home is 7.5 miles from the center of the **North circle**.

**How to Count:** Garden watchers will report the highest number of individuals of any species seen at one time in the garden. Do not add the total observations for the entire day. For example, a garden watcher may walk through his/her garden 3x in an hour. On the first pass s/he saw 3 monarchs and 5 zebras. On the second pass, 2 monarchs and 8 zebras. On the third pass, 4 monarchs and 6 zebras. S/he will report on this form that s/he saw 4 monarchs and 8 zebras. **Please be specific: Vague data will not be included! (ie – “too many to count, etc.)**
